SMALL SCHOOLS SWIMMING CARNIVAL

Don't forget the Small schools swimming carnival is on tomorrow. All students need to be at the pool by 9.30am for a 9.45am start. Cost for entry is \$3 for swimmers. Students are asked to wear their orange sports uniform.

Reminder: there will be no 'free time' in the pool during the carnival and under 8s will not be allowed in the big pool at all throughout the day.

Don't forget your hat, rashi, sunscreen, towel, warm clothes, recess and lunch (if not ordering) and plenty of drinking water.

BUS INFORMATION

Parents please make sure your children are registered with Transport for NSW & their details are up to date. If your child has just started Kindergarten or gone into Year 3, they will need to reapply for a bus pass. This can be done on the Transport for NSW website https://transportnsw.info/school-travel-apply

Parents are also asked to remind children who catch school buses of the following:

- Seatbelts are to be worn at **all times** on the buses.
- No eating unless for medical reasons.
- Students are to be at bus stops (school & home) 5 mins before departure.



SCHOOL TIMES
