Students and families are invited to enter the Stewart House Charity Drive for 2025. Your \$2 donation could win you a \$4000 gift voucher.

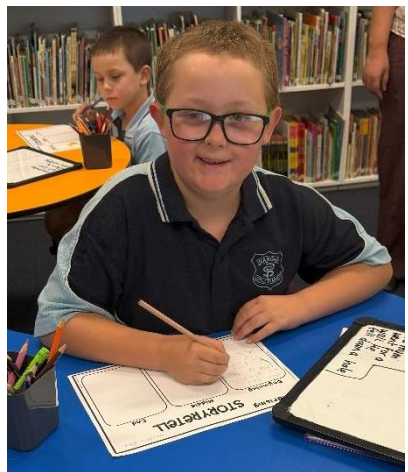
To enter simply complete your details on the attached envelope, insert a donation of at least \$2, seal the envelope and return to school.
